A. Charles Dickens is often considered to be one of the greatest novelists of the Victorian Era. Dickens's work remains hugely popular to this day and is praised for its realism, prose style, characters, comedy and social criticism. Many of his books were published in monthly or weekly installments in magazines.

B. George Eliot, born Mary Anne Evans was a prominent English writer, journalist and translator of the Victorian Era. She wrote seven novels and is known best for her psychological fiction and realism. Although it was more or less acceptable to publish books under a female name during her time, she wanted to avoid falling into the stereotypical category of female fiction.

C. William Blake was an English poet and painter who lived in the 18th— 19th centuries in the Romantic age. During his time Blake was not recognized by fellow artists and poets and was considered

crazy. Later critics, however, praised his creativity for inventing his own personal mythology.

D. Sir Isaac Newton was an English scientist and mathematician. He is widely recognized one of the most important scientists of all time and a significant figure in the scientific revolution. His discoveries laid the foundation of classical mechanics. He contributed to the study of optics, co-invented calculus and built the first reflecting telescope.

E. Charlie Chaplin was an English actor, who became famous in the 1920s during the era of silent film. He was known for his on-stage persona in comedic roles. He is considered to be one of the most important people in the history of film, as he is probably the first well-known film star. When sound films appeared in the 1930s, he refused to star in them, producing his own silent films instead.
